## Treasurers Report

Year to date balance of ~\$8,000

Total balance is \$34,734 as of last week. Not all of the travel tournaments or hats have been paid yet.

Main project that is outstanding is finishing up the batting cages. Moving T-ball fields is still up in the air.

## Previous Meeting Minutes

### 1. 13U White Team

- There was a parent meeting and there is a parent interested in coaching (last name is King). There is one person interested, but they work a lot of nights and couldn't make all of the practices. There shouldn't be an issue with that as the other coaches can take care of the practices, the real need is for weekend tournaments. There are other parents able to help out with everything but coaching.

There was a reminder that background checks will need to get done.

- There's potential that there would be 2 other kids interested in joining the 13U White Team as well, who previously played for Wittenberg. It was discussed that the boundaries were dissolved by Babe Ruth heading into the 2019 season, so that isn't an issue at this time.
- It was mentioned that there was also a kid who historically played for the Wausau Comets who is a 12U that would be interested in playing as well as it sounds like the Comets may have

dissolved.

## 2. Advertising Coordinator

Kevin Quevilion has been named the Advertising Coordinator. He is the Director of Big Brothers Big Sisters of Portage County. Vice President May met with him. He is used to fundraising and will be a good fit for the position. The forms have been updated for sponsorships.

The renewal cost is the same as a new banner, less \$50. The pricing is the same as last year.

## 3. Summer Tournaments

The Chippewa Falls 12U and 14U teams should be added to the tournament roster for the June 26-28 tournament. We are still waiting on the check for registration.

Discussion ensued regarding other teams that have contacted us and what efforts should be made to get the tournaments better advertised.

## 4. Important Dates for 2020 Season

Tentative Dates are March 7 and 14. Location is yet to be determined. Priebe will follow up on location options. Time would be from 9AM to 1PM. Discussion on shirts in storage from previous years was had. There appear to be enough shirts in storage that no new shirts will need to be ordered this year.

Dave Langbehn and the Varsity Team are available on March 7, but there is a conflict with the Run To Remember on March 14.

It was noted Spring Break is the 22<sup>nd</sup> thru the 29<sup>th</sup> of March.

Evaluations are planned for April 4<sup>th</sup> and the draft on April 7<sup>th</sup>. Priebe will follow up on gym times on the 4<sup>th</sup>.

Fitting dates: Olafson mentioned picking a few dates and a location to have the kids try on the uniforms. (February 3 and 6 were the dates mentioned location in the Greenheck lobby from 6PM to 7PM). Information will be sent out to the players on the travel teams. If jersey from last year still fits there wouldn't be a need to participate, but they would still need to report what their number is. If a player wants to get a new jersey because the old jersey doesn't fit, they would be able to get a new one.

Hat order: It was mentioned that 140 hats were planned to be ordered this year. It was mentioned with the 8U and 9U this year there will be a lot of younger kids needing hats. There are 109 kids currently signed up for travel. Timing of the hat order was discussed to ensure hats are in before tournaments start in May.

## 5. Further Discussion Items

Volunteering at the home tournaments was discussed. There needs to be an emphasis to have a Team Parent coordinate volunteers for concessions, in particular. Field maintenance was discussed and is something that we may not want volunteers for, but would possibly look at hiring others to do this task.

Discussion on moving T-ball fields to Kennedy was mentioned. The limiting factor is when the snow melts there is little time to get the work done.

Batting cage construction was mentioned too how this should be done before the season starts as well. There will be 2 batting cages installed. Maguire will price out concrete for the next meeting and have a design put together.

May brought up the flag pole and installing it near the Jones 2 score board. This will be done this

spring as well.

Equipment for travel coaches was discussed. Hitting nets and tees were given to coaches. It was brought up that Dick's Sporting Goods is giving the League \$250 to spend online which can be used on nets, balls, etc.

A travel parent meeting was discussed how we should have one late March/early April. Discussed breaking up the age groups so the meetings were more manageable.
